MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (2009)





UNIVERSITI BRUNEI DARUSSALAM Brunei Darussalam MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING KAGAWA UNIVERSITY Japan BETWEEN AND

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed this Review 2009, between Universiti Branet Darussalam thereinather referred to as "UBD") and Kagawa University, Japan thereinather referred to as "KU"), hereinather collectively referred to as "the Participants and individually referred to as "the Participant" unless otherwise described.

UBD and KU are desirons of collaborating and establishing a working relationship and, provides for the establishment of an academic link and cooperation between the Participants.

Based on principles of equity and reciprocity, this Memorandum of Understanding will serve as a general framework for cooperation between the two Participants and is intended to facilitate discussions for more specific programmes of collaboration.

SCOPE AND FIELDS OF ACADEMIC LINK AND COOPERATION

Within fields that are mutually acceptable to both institutions, the academic link and cooperation between UBD and KU will include the following:

Exchange of Students

Exchange of Students, both undergraduate and postgraduate, may take place for the purpose of visit, study or research for a duration to be mutually agreed. Students may be accepted as non-graduating students and/or for altachments to undertake duration on such terms and conditions to be agreed upon mutually in writing between the two Participants.

Exchange of Staff

Exchange of Staff

Exchange of Staff

Staff between the two Participants may take place for purposes that will be mutually beneficial to both Participants.

The Participants agree to exchange academic, estentific, historical and research publications and literature in areas of agreed munu doillocation between their libraries. Collaborative Research and Teaching Programmes
The Participants agree to explore possibilities of developing joint or collaborative research and teaching programmes in fields of
mutual interest. Such collaborative research and teaching programmes may include seminars bedding to publications, field work
for joint research, projects, about courses, summer schools and team teaching. The Participants which initiates a research project
or other activity in a field of likely interest to the other Participant will, wherever possible, invite staff of the latter Participant to
participate in the project on such terms and conditions to be agreed upon mutually in writing between the two Participants.

Cooperation in Other Areas
The academic link and cooperation between the Participants may be extended to other areas not mentioned above, subject to manual agreement in writing.

Section 2 EXCHANGE PROCEDURE

The procedures to be followed in implementing any exchange scheme or any form of cooperative work under this Memorandum of Understanding will be as follows:

The scope, terms, conditions and other details of any exchange programme or cooperative work to be implemented by the Participants shall be separately negotiated by representatives of both Participants, and confirmed by the Participants through specific and detailed Agreement's Agreement of the Society and detailed Agreement's any proposed exchange programme or cooperative work shall not be binding until approved in writing by the relevant authorities of both Participants under the signatures of the Vice Chanceltor of UBD and the President of RU.

The exchange of staff, students or publications need not be reciprocal simultaneously

Section 3 FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The financial arrangements in establishing any exchange programme or any form of cooperative work under this Memorandum of Understanding will be based on the following principles:

Both Participants understand that all financial arrangements for any exchange programme or cooperative work will have to be negociated and matually agreed in writing between the Participants depending on the availability of fands.

Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either Participant, nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out this Memorandum of Understanding.

Section 4 JOINT INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The following provisions on intellectual property rights will apply:

All findings derived from the collaborative research between both Participants under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be the joint intellectual property of both Participants, unless otherwise mutually agreed by the Participants.

Both Participants shall acknowledge one another in any form of writing, publication or presentation based on, or derived from, the collaborative research between both Participants under this Memorandum of Understanding, unless otherwise manually agreed by the Participants.

Section 5 CONFIDENTIALITY

The following provision will apply:

Both Participants agree to treat all information pertaining to, or derived from, this Memorandum of Understanding, obtained in thing or by other means during, and after the expiration of this Memorandum of Understanding as confidential, and shall not transmit such information without the written consent of the Participants giving the information.

Section 6 DURATION AND TERMINATION

The following provisions will apply:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall commence on the date of signature and shall continue to be effective for 5-years. There this infinite Joyear period, the Memorandum of Understanding will be extended for further 5-years periods unless both Participats matually agree in writing to its termination.

Notwithstanding the paragraph immediately above, this Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either Participant giving written aotice to the other at least 6-months prior to the date of expiry or to the proposed date of termination.

Notwithstanding the paragraph immediately above, the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding, or any other written agreement in respect of any on-going exchange programme or cooperative work under this Memorandum of Understanding, shall continue to apply until their completion unless both Participants mutually agree in writing to the earlier termination of the programme or cooperative work.

Section 7 MISCELLANEOUS

For the purposes under this Memorandum of Understanding, the responsible authorized signatories shall be the Vice Chancelor of Universiti Brune Darussalam and the President of Kagawa University.

Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding will be construed as creating any legal obligation between the two Participants

AGREEMENT ON EXCHANGE PROGRAMME (2012)





AGREEMENT ON EXCHANGE PROGRAMME BETWEEN UNIVERSITI BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

KAGAWA UNIVERSITY

Pursuant to the Memorrandum of Understanding between Universiti Branei Durussalam (hereinnther referred to as "KLT") concluded on 8 November 2009, UBD and KU (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually referred to as the "Parties" and individually referred to as the "Parties" and individually referred to as the "Party") have agreed to easy out the muntal exchange of flexiby members, researchers, undergraduate and gradoute students in accordance to the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Each university may exchange no more than five (5) students per year irrespective of undergraduate of graduate students (bereinabler referred to as the "Exchange Students"). However, if more than five (5) students appear to participate in the exchange program per year, this quota may be increased through mutual deliberation and in writing between the Parties.

 The bost university shall provide proper teaching to the Exchange Students in a specialized academic
- The Exchange Students participating in the exchange programme shall be those who are recommended by the home university on the basis of their academic performance and good conduct. The duration of stay for the Exchange Students shall not be more than one (1) year unless manually arca.
- agreed between the Parties.

 The Parties agreed that the responsibility for futtion and other expenses are as follows:

 (i) The host university will waive the admission fee, examination fee and tuition fee from the Exchange Students.
 - (ii) Payment for accommodation, all travel expenses, medical insurance and subsistence costs shall be the sole responsibility of each Exchange Students. Both Parties shall assist the Exchange Students in finding appropriate necommodation in accordance with the Exchange Students'
 - Although the Exchange Students will not be awarded a degree status at the host university, the host university shall mail a transcript belonging to each fixchange Student concerned to the home university at the end of the exchange term. The credits shall be approved by the home university.
 - Exchange Students participating in the exchange program should comply with the regulations of the host universities

The faculty members and researchers shall be solely responsible for their own travel expenses and other subsistence costs. Both Puries shall assist in finding appropriate accommodation. Esculty Members and Researchers

Any amendment or revision to this Agreement shall be made by mutual written agreement of both Amendment and Revision

Dispute Resolution

10. Any difference or dispute arising out of the interpretation, implementation or application of the provisions of this Agreement will be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation between the Parties without reference to any third party or international tribunal

- Each Party decides to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to the other Party during the period of the implementation of this
- Both Parties decide that the provisions of Clause 11 will continue to have effect between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement

Effect of Exchange Agreement

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This Agreement serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to may legal process and will not deemed to constitute or create any legal process.

Effective Date and Renewal

- This Agreement shall come into effect on the date of its signing by the parties and shall remain in force and in effect for five (5) years from the date of signing or such later date as mutually agreed by the Parties. ž
- This Agreement can be remewed for another five (5) years by mutual written agreement of both Parties. Any Party may terminate this Agreement before its expiry date by giving six (6) month's written notice to the other Party before its expiry date. 5

This Agreement is made both in Jayanese and English. Signed in duplicate, both texts being equally authenties, by the authorized signatories on behalf of the Parties. In the event of dispute in interpretation, the English version of this Agreement will be used.
